

How do I obtain benefits?

For each child, benefits for education and participation in social life must be applied for separately to the authority that pays for your basic needs.

Apart from payment for educational materials and school transport, all benefits are **not** given as a sum of money. You will either receive vouchers or a confirmation that the costs will be covered, which you can present to the institution providing the service or goods.

Important note: Keep all receipts, invoices or other proof of activities or registration so you can present them to your funding agency (Leistungsträger) if necessary.

Who is entitled to benefits according to the educational package?

Children and young people up to the age of 25 who attend a school of general or vocational education and who do not receive apprenticeship pay can receive benefits for education and participation in social life in addition to the regular needs. This also applies to children and young people whose parents qualify for other social benefits,

such as:

- Unemployment benefit II (Arbeitslosengeld II - SGB II)
- Social Allowance (Sozialgeld - SGB II)
- Benefits of Social Welfare (Sozialhilfe - SGB XII)
- Housing benefit (Wohngeld)
- Supplementary Child allowance (Kinderzuschlag)
- benefits according to the Asylum Seekers Benefits Act (Asylbewerberleistungsgesetz AsylbLG)

What is paid for under the educational package?

One-day school or Kindergarten trips and longer school trips

For pupils and children in day care centers, nurseries, Kindergarten or Tagespflege, costs for one-day trips can be paid for. The same applies to school trips of several days.

School materials

Pupils receive 70 euros at the beginning of the school year and 30 euros in the second half of the year.

Transportation to/from school

Pupils/students from class 11 on (Sekundarstufe II), who attend the nearest secondary school which they cannot reach on foot or by bicycle will receive a transport allowance if the cost is not covered by anyone else.

Lunch at day care centres, schools and after-school care centres

Pupils and children in Kindergarten and other day care centres can receive an allowance for dinner if these institutions offer lunch in their own canteen. The family share of the costs is one euro per child per day.

Learning support

If there is a risk of having to repeat a year and no other support is available at your child's school, then learning support (Nachhilfe) can be paid for. A written confirmation from the school that your child cannot achieve a learning goal without support is necessary.

Cultural, sports and leisure activities

For taking part in cultural, sports and leisure activities, children and young people up to his or her 18th birthday can receive a monthly allowance of 10 euros. "Banking" over a longer period of time is possible.
